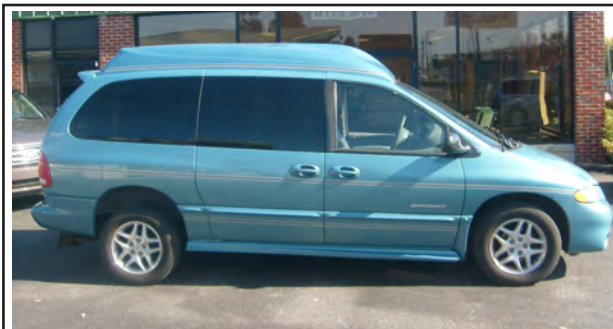
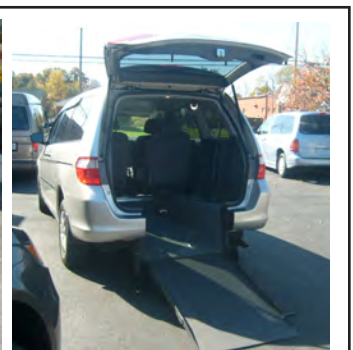

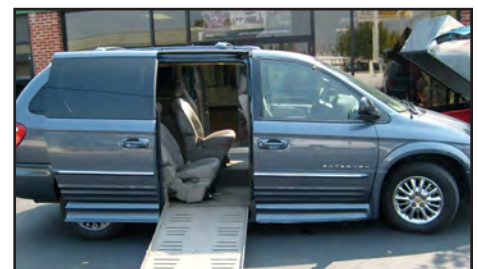

Mobile *Lifestyle* Advisor

Need answers to your mobility questions?? Want to know the latest in Assistive Technology? Would you like to learn

money saving tips on how to purchase your next van, scooter or lift? Get these answers and more from “The Mobile Lifestyle Advisor” brought to you by Disabled Dealer of Virginia and West Virginia. This column might make you roll with laughter, cringe with fear, or jump for joy, but it guarantees to produce solutions that you can take to the bank. So “*Let’s Get Rolling*”.

Q. I would love to have one of those minivans with the ramp so my daughter could get her power wheelchair up into it without me having to transfer her into a seat. She is small in stature (under 80 lbs) so I am wondering if it is safe for her to sit in the front seat area in her wheelchair with the front air bag.

A. A great question which has not been asked since I have been writing this column. Safety has been a paramount issue with all the major lowered floor minivan converters as well as NMEDA dealers. Since the inception of the lowered floor minivan, manufactures have worked closely with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to address the safety of wheelchair seating positions and have provided safe, certified options for wheelchair users. In your case, the safe option is to have the passenger side air bag deactivated when the wheelchair passenger is riding. This is legal provided you have a registered NMEDA dealer do the install. Most deactivation kits have a key option which allows you to cut the air bag on or off depending on who is riding in the van. While the rider in the wheelchair is in the front passenger position the air bag is off and you would use the OEM shoulder/lap belt for safety and security or to make it easy and quick, an EZ Lock system would be the best. The whole key is having a certified NMEDA dealer do the air bag lock out and also the fitting for the securement system. Thanks for the question.

Q. How much weight will my lowered floor wheelchair hold? Robert H.—VA.

A. In the conversion process of a lowered floor minivan the manufacture has removed parts, added parts and realigned parts thus changing the OEM specifications of the typical minivan. Without modification the carrying capacity including cargo and passengers would be about 1500 lbs. The conversion of most minivans adds weight so you have to deduct this from the OEM specification. Since about 2007 most converted

vans have a sticker on the inside of the driver doorjamb that will state the total cargo and passenger weight the van will carry,(don’t be surprised to see various stickers in the doorjamb addressing everything from tire pressure to “make inoperable” disclosures). If the sticker is not there a good rule of thumb is 300lbs. less than the OEM manufacture specs or in this case 1200 lbs total. I would caution you that even though that is the specification, you may still want to check your overall ground clearance as you add cargo weight. The specifications may say it will carry the load, however time may have weakened the suspension and you lose too much ground clearance to safely drive the vehicle on the road without causing damage.

Q. I love my new van, however it is much smaller than the full size van that I am used to. I am trying to position an EZ Lock so my daughter can easily drive her power chair up the ramp and lock in. It would be wonderful if she could back into the lock instead of pulling into the lock as she did in the full size van. Is this safe? Marlyne B.—VA.

A. In checking with the manufacture of EZ Lock, I was assured that IF the lock down was installed per their guidelines and that IF the pin and bracket on the wheelchair were installed per their guidelines then backing into the lock vs. pulling into the lock would be fine. Their testing results show the lock can be situated anyway needed to enable easy access. EZ Lock also recommends, and I am sure you have been, using a certified lap belt and shoulder harness for your daughter while she is riding in the van. I would NOT recommend you reinstall the old EZ Lock into the new van yourself. Their install requirements are quite specific and your daughter’s safety depends on the proper installation. Your local NMEDA mobility dealer would be the best to fit and correctly install the EZ Lock.
